Our Souls at Night ~ Kent Haruf



Us Against You ~ Fredrik Backman


The citizens of Beartown are about to lose their beloved hockey team and their rivals could not be happier. The book has you wondering who is going to die and why events occur as they do.

The Other Einstein ~ Marie Benedict



Everything I Never Told You ~ Celeste Ng



Killers of the Flower Moon: the Osage Murders and the Birth of the FBI ~ David Grann



A Tree Grows in Brooklyn ~ Betty Smith


A young girl in a shabby neighborhood lives with dreams in an innocent time before the war.
